



PET OWNER ETIQUETTE GUIDELINES

TO ENSURE THAT ALL RESIDENTS AND THEIR VISITORS AT
WELLINGTON ON THE LAKE AND THEIR PETS CAN ENJOY
LIVING HERE TOGETHER IN THIS BEAUTIFUL COMMUNITY....
PLEASE....

- Encourage your pets to pee and poop on their own property, not on others.
- “Poop and scoop” your pet’s waste and dispose of it, suitably bagged, appropriately at home or in the designated waste stations to be located soon throughout the Wellington on the Lake community for everyone’s convenience. A map will be provided once the waste stations are in place. Please see “Dog and Cat Feces Health Risks” attached.
- Walk your dog daily to ensure it gets adequate exercise. Please use common courtesy when walking your pet near other residents, cyclists, scooter, cars, etc., by keeping it on a short leash for everyone’s safety. See * below. Check out www.princeedwarddogpark.org/#! for an off-leash dog location at Delhi Park in Picton. Also, there is another area west of Wellington on the south side of Loyalist Parkway between Sandbanks and Kente wineries. It is fenced on three sides but not on the side leading to the road.
- Control excessive barking by your dog, both inside and outside your home to avoid annoying your neighbours. See * below and Prince Edward County (PEC) By-law #4.11.1.
- Do not leave your dog outside while unattended unless it is suitably confined to your property.
- Pets are not allowed in the Clubhouse or within the mail kiosk/tennis courts/pool area/gardens/woodshop/games area – with the exception of trained service dogs.
- All dogs must wear a licenced tag when not on their owners’ property. See PEC By-law #4.4.
- Cats should be confined to their owners’ property unless leashed.
